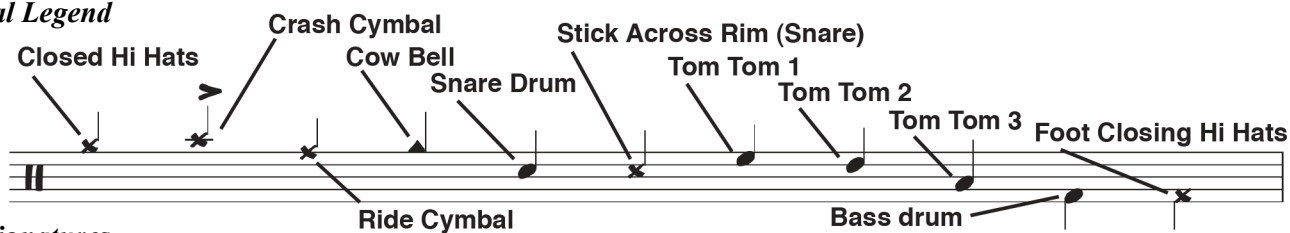

General Legend



Time Signatures

C = Common = 4 = The amount of beats — Four 2 = Two 4 = Four
 4 = The type of note for each beat — Quarter 4 = Quarter 8 = Eighth etc.

Bar Lines



R = Right Hand

L = Left Hand

B = Bass drum

O When placed on top of a cymbal note indicates opened hi hat cymbals.

X When placed on top of a cymbal note indicates closed hi hats with the foot.

⊕ When placed on top of a cymbal note indicates half opened hi hat cymbals.

→ When shown means to continue on (e.g: Bass drum, sticking, counting etc.)
